

GUIDELINES FOR GED TEST REGISTRATION and TEST FEE WAIVERS

Adults enrolled in GED classes sponsored by Rappahannock Area Regional Adult Education are eligible for split testing sessions and a waiver of the test fee.

To receive a test fee waiver, students have to:

- a) participate in an adult education class for at least **30** documented hours,
- b) have a valid pre test score on their class registration form, and **if the scaled score is less than 600, have a valid post test score.**
- c) pass all five GED Official Practice Tests (writing, math, reading, science, social studies) with at least a score of **450**.
- d) list GED as a goal on student learning plan, complete with set and target date.
- e) receive an "Official GED Test Fee Waiver Voucher" signed and dated by their instructor and submitted with test registration.

Adults registering for the all day Saturday sessions, which are open to the public, will still register with their local school system GED registrar.

If a student requests a test fee waiver for a Saturday test, the voucher must be sent to RARAE office prior to the student registering. The student and teacher will be contacted once the test fee waiver has been approved.

To register for a split testing session, students have to:

- a) be enrolled in a class sponsored by Rappahannock Area Regional Adult Education,
- b) secure a spot for a particular testing session **one week prior to the orientation session**, by calling the Regional Adult Education office at (540) 898-8165,
- c) attend the orientation and registration session prior to the first test,
- d) present a valid picture ID, legal document with the social security number, and evidence of local residence.
